
# Barney's Boating Survey

#### Q1 In your opinion is boating on the Cooks River an appropriate activity?









#### Q4 Have you ever been boating on the Cooks River?





#### Q5 If you answered YES to question 4, how often do you go boating on the Cooks River?







### Q7 What obstacles do you think might prevent more boating on the Cooks River? Check multiple boxes if applicable





## Q8 If you had the opportunity to go boating on the Cooks River, would you?




